STUDENT DRESS CODE POLICY
2011-2012



PURPOSE

- To focus on school as a workplace for students
- To focus students away from clothing label competition and inappropriate clothing
- To develop a sense of school family pride within the school

TOPS FOR BOYS & GIRLS: Solid white, navy blue, forest/dark green, Dailey/dark purple	Polo type shirts or blouses with collar, sleeves; shirt or blouse with collar, buttons down the front, short or long sleeves; turtleneck or mock turtleneck may be worn under collared shirt. No writing, labels or logos are allowed on tops. All children will keep their shirts tucked in.
BOTTOMS FOR BOYS & GIRLS: Solid navy blue, khaki (tan)	Pants or Capri Slacks- with or without cuffs, pleated, or plain; walking shorts - no shorter than mid-thigh; with or without cuffs, pleated or plain. No tears. No "sagging" or "baggies" - this means that all pants must stay up on the waist if a belt were removed. No athletic wear, sweats, or jeans.
BOTTOMS FOR GIRLS: Solid navy blue, khaki	Skorts (shorts with front flap) - No shorter than mid-thigh. No jeans. Skirts - No Shorter than mid-thigh (at least) pleated, gathered, or straight.
TIGHTS/LEGGINGS/BIKE SHORTS: Solid navy blue or white	Tights, leggings or bike shorts/work-out type shorts can be worn under skirts, skorts, shorts, or jumpers. **Leggings and bike shorts can ONLY be worn under an outfit and cannot be worn as a bottom alone.
BELTS FOR BOYS & GIRLS: Navy blue, black, or brown Plain or braided;	Leather-like or canvas-style; belts must be worn inside belt loops from beginning to end. Ends of belt cannot hang down from the buckle. No lettering on belt buckles.
SOCKS FOR BOYS & GIRLS: Plain white, navy blue, or khaki (tan)	Short or knee-hi style. Other colors are not acceptable
SHOES FOR BOYS & GIRLS: Plain white, navy blue, black or brown	High or low top; basic laced sneakers, oxfords, or short ankle-length boots. High athletic, high-tops with excessive colors and lights are not appropriate. High heels, platforms, sandals, thongs or Ugg type boots are not acceptable. Students must be in PE appropriate shoes daily.
SWEATERS/SWEATSHIRTS (OUTERWEAR) FOR BOYS & GIRLS: Solid white, navy blue, forest/dark green, Dailey/dark purple	Sweaters: cardigan, v-neck, or crew neck pullover; long-sleeve style pullover; ribbed or plain bottom edge; shirt collar must be visible. Sweatshirt: crew neck pullover; shirt collar must be visible. No writing, labels or logos are allowed on sweaters or sweatshirts. Sweatshirts with hoods are not permitted.
COATS FOR BOYS & GIRLS: Plain white, Dailey/dark purple, navy blue or black	Coats need to be solid colors without writing or markings on the outside. Coats may have hoods. (Black is only allowed for coats)
COSMETICS	Make-up is not to be worn nor is it permitted on campus. No temporary tattoos or fake fingernails.
HATS Solid navy blue, white, or khaki	Hats: caps, beanies, winter wear hats, etc. Hats may only be worn outside on the playground. They may not be worn inside any school building.
HAIR	Hair styles which draw undue attention and detract from the educational environment are not allowed; i.e. Mohawks, tails, colors, unusual razor cuts, or unusual designs.
FRIDAY SPIRITWEAR Apparel with Dailey logo	Wearing of spirit wear on Fridays is optional. Dailey T-Shirts and Dailey zipper sweatshirts are acceptable on Fridays <i>only</i> .

School is a place where the best possible educational environment must be created and maintained. Emphasis shall always be on neatness and cleanliness. School uniforms are acceptable. The dressing and grooming of students that tends to obstruct or inhibit the instructional program is prohibited.

Any apparel, hairstyle, or cosmetics, even if not specifically mentioned, which creates a safety concern, draws undue attention to the wearer, or which tends to detract from the educational process will not be accepted. Dailey is a graffiti free school.

Exceptions to the above rules may be made by the Principal for special events or as need arises.
