  - Time per task
  - Choice
  - Flexible Due Dates

# WHY THE CHANGE?

- Research findings are mixed in connecting homework and academic achievement (in elementary grades)
- Reinforcing the Learner Profile Attribute of Balanced

\*Research changes as students move into Middle and High School.

# PURPOSE OF HOMEWORK

## Short Term:

Develop habits and skills (ATLs) to promote long term academic achievement

Exs. Self-Management, Social Skills (IB)

- Organization- Planning and carrying out activities effectively
- Time management- Using time effectively and appropriately
- Accepting responsibility

# PURPOSE OF HOMEWORK

## Long Term:

Develop Self Regulation & Metacognitive Awareness

- Self Regulation– Students monitor their performance and adjust their strategies as a result of feedback
- Metacognitive awareness– assess interests, perceptions of ability, autonomy, optimal conditions to maximize learning preferences

# FAMILIES MATTER

## WHAT YOU CAN DO AT HOME...

- Give your child choice and voice (if possible) in the location and time of homework
- Support skill being taught as well as content
  - Time Management of a week-long project
  - Talk alouds on the steps you would take to complete something

# FAMILIES MATTER

## WHAT YOU CAN DO AT HOME...

- Have a positive attitude towards homework
- Use language and phrases that strengthen a growth mindset
  - “This may take us some time”
  - “What can you try instead?”
  - “What can you do to make your answer even better?”
  - “How did that mistake help you understand the problem better?”

“HOW WAS YOUR DAY?” (SILENCE)  
“WHAT DID YOU DO TODAY?” (NOTHING)

Instead...

- ★ What questions did you ask today?
- ★ Which book did you choose at the library this week? Why?
- ★ What is something you laughed about today?
- ★ Tell me about something you learned today.

When checking homework or reviewing classwork...

- ★ Show me how you...
- ★ Which \_(book)\_ is your favorite? Why?
- ★ Tell me about how you found this answer?
