What is Dailey?

- Independent charter school
- Authorized by Fresno Unified
- Governed by its own Board of Directors and policies
- Implements the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Program
- Accelerated learning (grade level and above)
- Holds students accountable to both high academic and behavioral expectations
- Teaches all state standards and partakes in state assessments

How does a charter school work?

What is it?

- A public school that operates outside of a school district
- It can create its own operational systems
- Creates an “open sector” within the public education system
- Operates under limited-term, performance-based agreement called a “Charter Petition”

How are we funded?

- ADA (average daily attendance)
- LCFF (local control funding formula)
- Fundraising
