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COVID-19 VIRUS UPDATE

Dear Families,

Dailey is vigilant in following guidance and direction from health experts both at the California Department of Public Health and the Fresno County Department of Public Health. Governor Newsome issued new guidance yesterday involving group gatherings of over 250 people. Gatherings that do not meet the 250 thresholds should only be conducted when they are essential. Dailey, among many other districts, is defining essential functions, "as anything that is essential to the operation of a school site, student learning and/or governance of our school."

Due to new updates regarding the COVID-19 virus, the following will be put in place beginning March 16th:

- No high fives or handshakes
- Staggered lunch schedule with outdoor eating when weather permits
 - Kindergarten 10:50 - 11:30
 - First Grade 11:20 – 12:00
 - Second Grade 11:50 - 12:30
 - Third Grade 12:20 – 1:00
 - Fourth/Fifth Grade 12:50 – 1:30
- Everyday disinfecting of classrooms and common spaces
- No volunteers
- Limited visitors
- Students with asthma and or other medical concerns will be distanced as recommend by Health Officials
- Shamrock Shuffle and Open House are postponed to a later date
- All field trips are cancelled
- Assemblies are cancelled
- All parent meetings are cancelled
- Birthday celebrations will be with students only and snacks will be selected by the individual students

With many lunches moving to a later time, please pack extra snacks for your student. We will let all families know when postponed events have a new date.

In the event the school needs to close please make sure that your emergency contact information and address are up to date in the office.



If your child is feeling unwell, please keep them at home.

Thank you for your continued support as we try to ensure all our students' health and wellbeing is taken care of while also providing a routine learning environment.
