What is Distance Learning?

“Distance learning” means instruction in which the student and instructor are in different locations.

- Interaction with students through computer or other technology to deliver instruction
- May include video, audio instruction
- It may also include print materials incorporating print materials incorporating assignments

Grades from 3rd quarter will roll over to 4th quarter

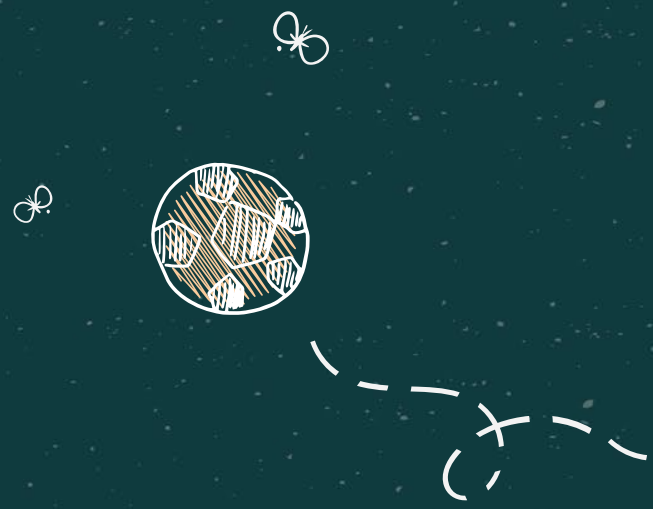
- Students are expected to complete the assignments that teachers are posting to the best of their ability
