

Dear Dailey Families,

We would like to inform you that we will be moving forward with our normal five days a week school schedule for the 2020-2021 school year. If online learning legislation is passed prior to our first day on August 17, 2020, Dailey will offer this option to families who are interested along with an updated policy. We have selected the normal schedule as we feel it is the safest option for our students and most beneficial for our working families.

Many modifications will be put in place to support students' health and safety while they are on campus. The following are modifications that will be put in place:

- Masks and/or face shields for everyone on campus when indoors
  - If possible, masks should be in solid colors
  - No sports teams allowed
- Social distancing
- No mixing of classrooms
- No school events
- Staggered Arrival Times
  - 7:15 a.m. - 7:30 a.m.
    - Kindergarten, First and Second Grade
  - 7:30 a.m. - 7:45 a.m.
    - Third, Fourth, and Fifth Grade
  - Siblings can come together
  - Valet traffic enters campus on Harrison Ave.
  - Walking traffic enters campus on N. Farris Ave.
  - Temperatures will be taken
    - 100.4 Fahrenheit or higher will not be allowed on campus
- Parents and guardians will not be allowed on campus
- Staggered Dismissal Times
  - Kindergarten 1:30 p.m. on Harrison
  - 3:15 p.m. - 3:20 p.m.
    - First and Second Grade
  - 3:20 p.m. - 3:30 p.m.
    - Third, Fourth, and Fifth Grade
  - Older siblings will be dismissed with younger siblings
- Students will need to bring a water bottle to school

As we get closer to the start of the school year, we will be providing more information on systems and procedures. Please have a safe and healthy summer. We can't wait to see our Dragons in August!
