- 1) When will sign-ups be available for the Kindergarten walk through?  
*We are hoping to have them available by the end of next week.*
- 2) How many students are allowed in each classroom?  
*There will be 10-14 students in each classroom depending on the grade level.*
- 3) Is it possible that the students will be asked to return sooner if the waiver is approved?  
*No, the soonest we would open campus would be the end of October.*
- 4) If a Kindergarten class only has 14 students who wanted to return, would that class go in person each day?
  - a. *No. What we do for one grade level, we have to do for all of them.*
- 5) Would the 3rd cohort be learning exclusively online?  
*We would only have to open a 3rd cohort if we have requests for more in-person learning.*
- 6) Can we opt out of in-person learning if we don't feel comfortable with our kid in school?  
*Yes. Families can continue with online learning. If at any point you feel like online learning would be a better option for your family you may move to that format. .*
- 7) What was due today as far as signing up online?  
*The form for Online Learning was due today (October 5th)*
- 8) When do we return to learning in person?
