



# Dailey Elementary Charter School Uniform Dress Code Policy



**Purpose:** Dailey Elementary Charter School upholds a school uniform policy to maintain a focus on the school being a learning place for students. The policy helps foster a sense of school pride and professionalism.

Parent/Guardian may be required to remedy the dress code requirement in order for students to be within the Uniform Dress Code Policy if loaners are not available.

All students will follow the Uniform Dress Code Policy everyday without exception. The focus at Dailey is firmly on academics. Habitual breaking of the Uniform Dress Code Policy will not be tolerated.
